Other Water Usage

Residential irrigation shall be limited to hand-held hoses, hand-held buckets, drip irrigation, or permanently installed automatic sprinkler system only allowed between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

Even # residential addresses
 Sundays and Thursdays

Odd # residential addresses
 Saturdays and Wednesdays

All other Tuesdays and Fridays
 only between 8:00 p.m.
 and 12:00 a.m. (midnight)

Irrigation of green belts,
 esplanades and sports field
 shall be prohibited.

Use of water for all outdoor purposes such as irrigation, fountains, reflecting pools, and water gardens shall be prohibited.

The following uses of water are defined as non-essential and are prohibited:

- 1. wash down of any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, or other hard-surfaced areas;
- 2. use of water to wash down buildings or structures for purposes other than immediate fire protection;
- 3. use of water for dust control;
- 4. flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter or street; and
- 5. failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak(s).

Use of water from hydrants shall be limited to firefighting, related activities, or other activities necessary to maintain public health, safety, and welfare. The use of water for construction purposes from designated fire hydrants under special permit is to be discontinued.

All restaurants are prohibited from serving water to patrons except upon request of the patron.

No application for new, additional, expanded, or increased-in-size water service connections, meters, service lines, pipeline extensions, mains, or water service facilities of any kind shall be approved, and time limits for approval of such applications are hereby suspended for such time as this drought response stage or a higher-numbered stage shall be in effect.

In the event that water shortage conditions threaten public health, safety and welfare, the District may implement additional measures.

Repair detectable leaks within 72 hours of discovery.
