

Forest Oaks Park Fishing Guidelines and Policies

Updated 4/22/24

- Fishing license **IS REQUIRED** in Forest Oaks Park lakes.
- All park visitors must provide photo identification when requested by Forest Oaks staff, security officers, or law enforcement officers.
- Inspection of all coolers, buckets, and stringers can be conducted by Forest Oaks staff, security officers, or law enforcement officers. Refusal to allow inspection will result in your removal from park.
- Fish Catch and Release Policy
 - Bass (large or smallmouth) - **Catch and release only**
 - Channel and blue catfish - **Follow fishing license**
 - Yellow and Mud Catfish - **Follow fishing license**
 - Bluegill (brim) - **Follow fishing license**
 - Black and White Crappie - **Follow fishing license**
 - Carp - **Follow fishing license**
 - Drum - **Follow fishing license**
 - Gar - **Follow fishing license**
 - Tilapia - **Follow fishing license**
 - Any fish not listed - follow fishing license.
 - Taking bass from lakes may result in a trespass citation from Constables.
- Fishing rod/pole limits and restrictions:
 - All anglers are limited to TWO fishing rods/poles per person if fishing on dock.
 - All anglers are limited to THREE fishing rods/poles per person if not on dock.
 - Prohibited fishing equipment includes: Cast nets, seine nets, jug lines, trotlines, string lines.
- Please dispose of all of your trash before leaving your fishing spot(s) and/or park.
- Do not fish from any spillways or rock structures.
