Irrigation

Residential irrigation only allowed between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

No irrigation on Mondays
Even # residential addresses
Sundays and Thursdays
Odd # residential addresses
Saturdays and Wednesdays
All other Tuesdays and Fridays
only between 8:00 p.m.
and 12:00 a.m. (midnight)
Irrigation of green belts,
esplanades and sports field
shall be limited to Tuesday
and Fridays between 8:00
p.m. and 12:00 a.m.
(midnight)

Other Water Usage

The following actions are prohibited except on designated watering days between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

- Please use a hand-held bucket or a hand-held hose with a positive shutoff nozzle for quick rinses.
- Use of water to wash motor vehicles of any kind, boats, trailers, airplane or other vehicles.
 - This excludes commercial car wash businesses or commercial service stations.
- Filling, refilling, or adding water to any type of pool, spa, or jacuzzi-type pool.

Operation of any ornamental fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes is prohibited except where necessary to support aquatic life or where such fountains or ponds are equipped with a recirculation system.

Use of fire hydrants shall be limited to firefighting related activities or other activities necessary to maintain public health, safety, and welfare, except that use of water from designated fire hydrants for construction purposes may be allowed under special permit from the District.

Use of water for the irrigation of golf courses and fairways is prohibited except on designated watering days between the hours of 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. However, if the golf course utilizes a water source other than that provided by the District, the facility shall not be subject to these regulations.

All restaurants are prohibited from serving water to patrons except upon request of the patron.

The following uses of water are defined as non-essential and are prohibited:

- wash down of any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, or other hardsurfaced areas;
- use of water to wash down buildings or structures for purposes other than immediate fire protection;
- use of water for dust control;
- flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter or street; and
- failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak(s).

Repair detectable leaks within 72 hours of discovery.
