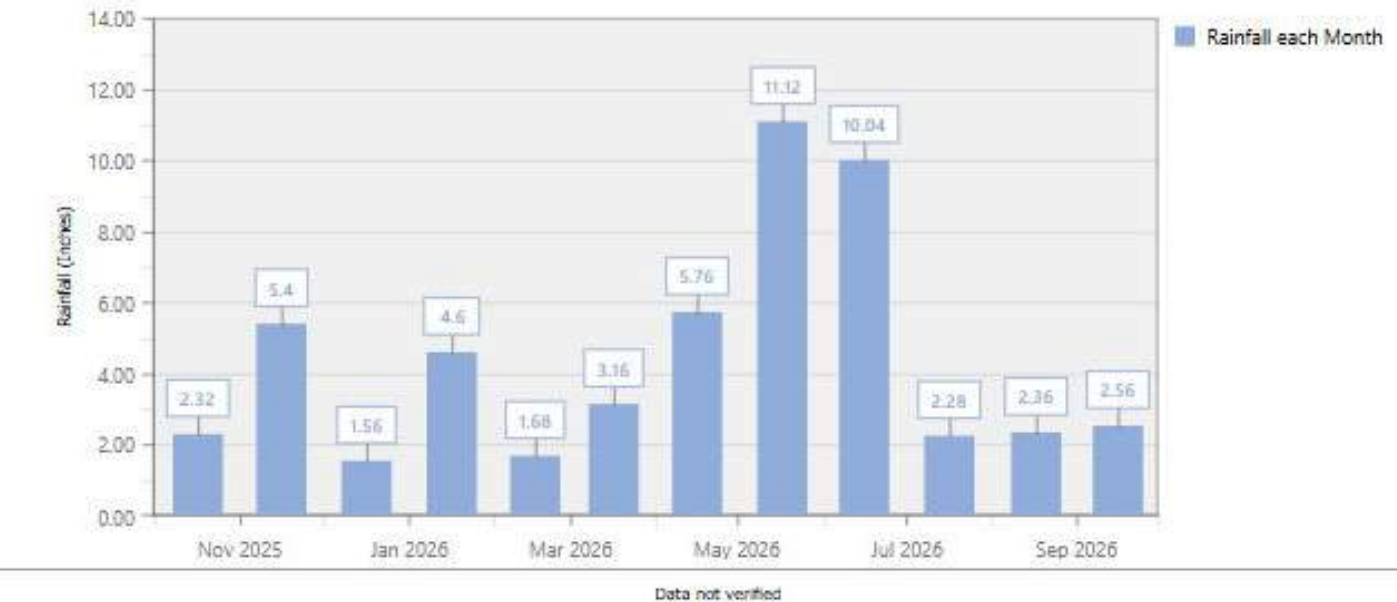

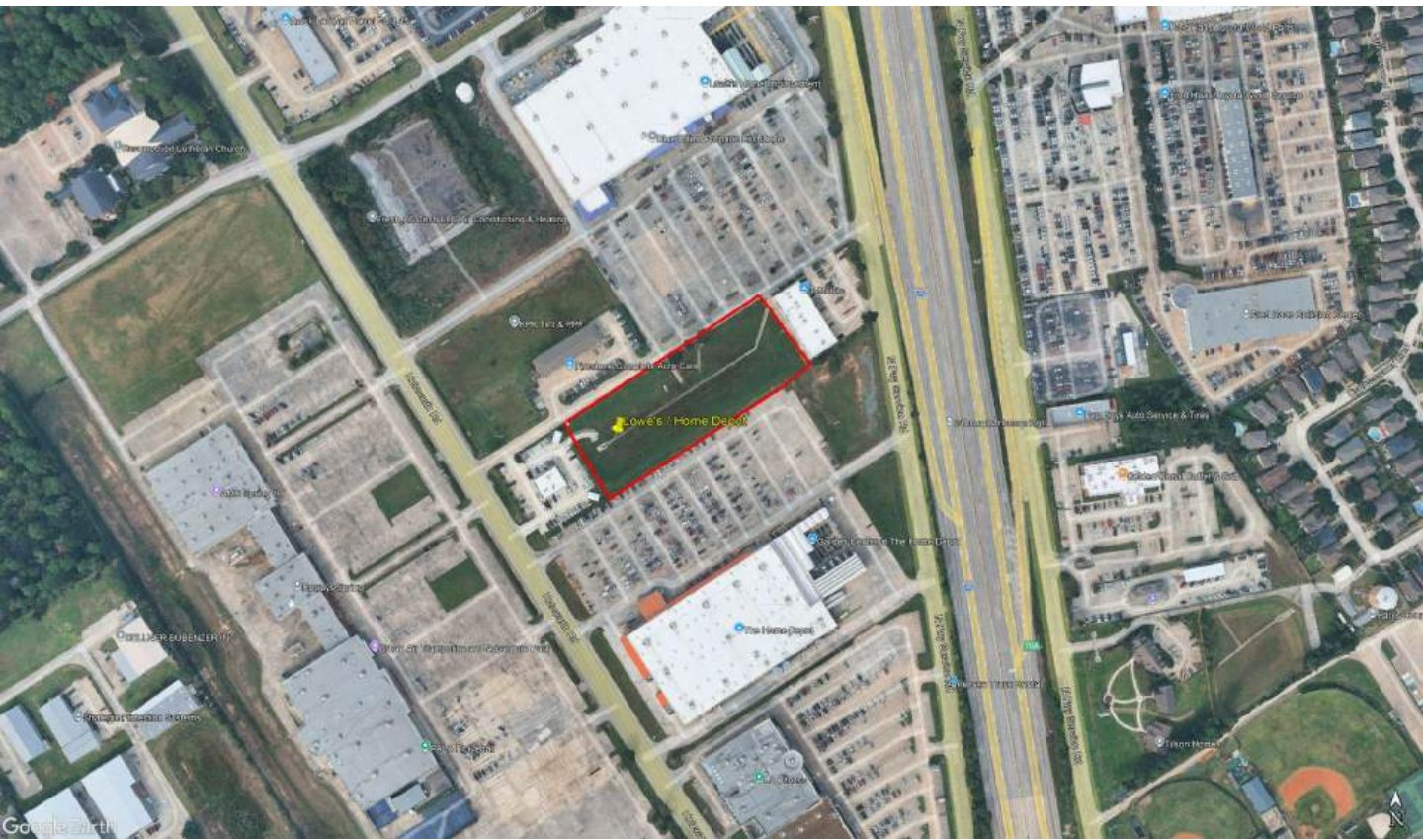

Cypress Forest Reserve D & E Detention Ponds

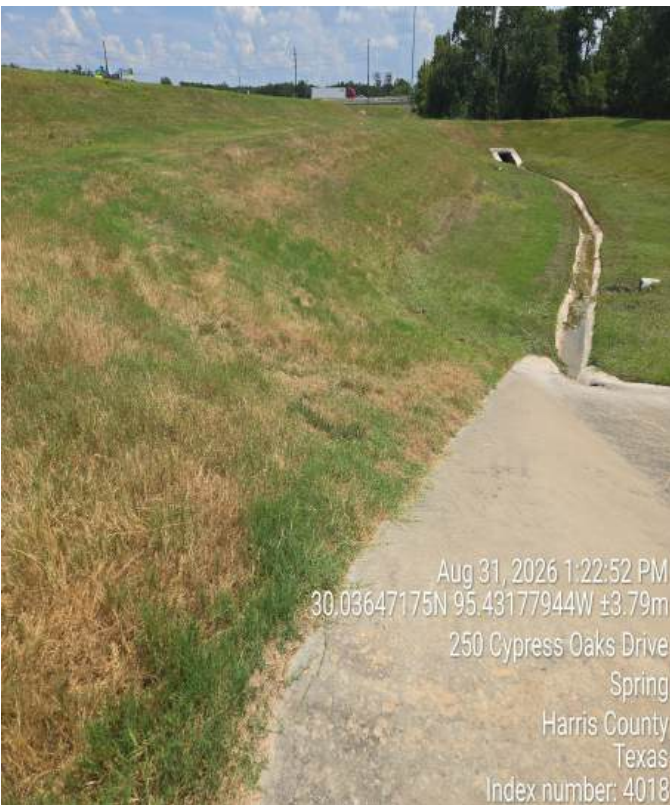

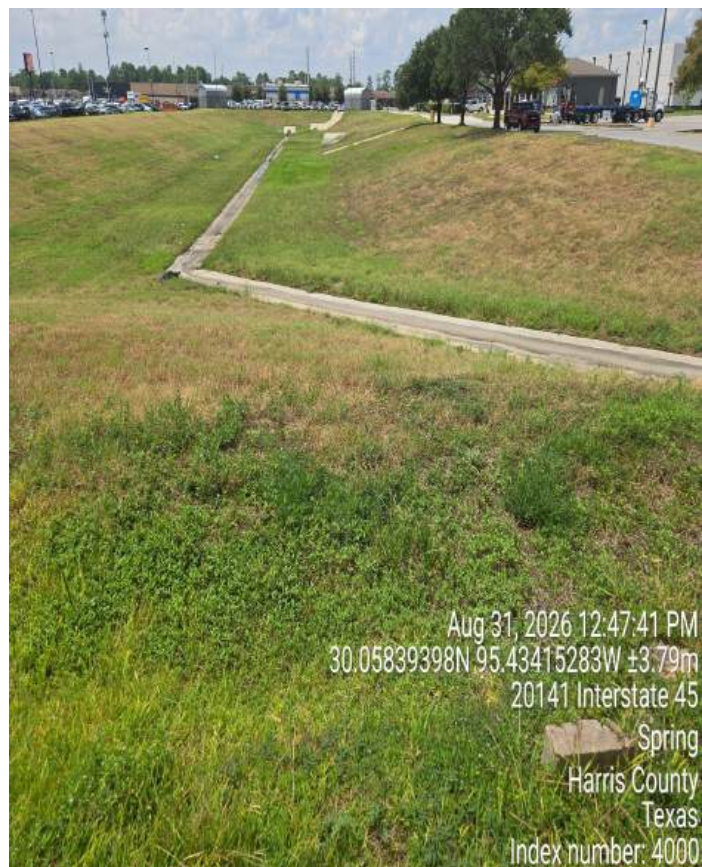


Cypress Forest Reserve Hendricks Lots
